Mr. Stefan Pretterhofer assumed his position as Deputy Permanent Representative of Austria to the United Nations in New York in August 2023.

Prior to his appointment as Deputy Permanent Representative, Mr. Pretterhofer held a number of positions. He was a Member of the Cabinet of Federal Minister Alexander Schallenberg in the Federal Ministry for European and International Affairs of Austria (August 2020 to July 2023). He worked as Head of Unit for South and Southeast Asia in the Department for Asia and the Pacific (October 2019 to July 2020), as Counsellor at the Permanent Mission of Austria to the United Nations in New York (November 2014 to September 2019), as First Secretary and Attaché at the Austrian Embassy in Budapest (July 2010 to October 2014 and October 2009 to April 2010 respectively). He also worked as desk officer in the Department for Tourist and Cross-Border Traffic, the Department for Bilateral and Multilateral Trade Relations and the Department for Eastern and South Eastern Europe.

Mr. Pretterhofer holds a bachelor's degree in Business Administration, a master's degree in Management and International Business and a master's degree in Law from the University of Graz, Austria. He also spent a year as an exchange student at the Institut d'études politiques de Paris ("Sciences Po").
