Resumen

De conformidad con lo dispuesto en la decisión 2009/11 de la Junta Ejecutiva, en la presente nota se informa a la Junta Ejecutiva acerca de la prórroga por dos meses de los programas para Camboya y Filipinas y de la primera prórroga por un año del programa para Namibia, aprobadas por la Directora Ejecutiva.

En la presente nota se informa asimismo a la Junta Ejecutiva de los motivos que sostienen la propuesta de prorrogar por un año el programa para la República Popular Democrática de Corea, tras dos prórrogas consecutivas por un año. Se solicita que la Junta Ejecutiva apruebe esta prórroga.

Proyecto de decisión

La Junta Ejecutiva

1. *Toma nota* de las prórrogas por dos meses de los programas para Camboya y Filipinas y de la prórroga por un año del programa para Namibia, que fueron aprobadas por la Directora Ejecutiva, como se indica en el cuadro 1.

2. *Aprueba* la prórroga por un año del programa para la República Popular Democrática de Corea tras dos prórrogas consecutivas por un año, como se indica en el cuadro 2.

Namibia	2019–2023	January–December 2024 (<i>one-year extension</i>)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – This extension will allow the UNSDCF to be synchronized with the Sixth National Development Plan (NDP6) 2025/26–2030/31. – The country team has reached consensus on the request and agreed to the extension of the current framework until 31 December 2024. – The extension of the CPD has been requested to facilitate alignment with the new UNSDCF, which begins in 2025.
Philippines	2019–2023	January–February 2024 (<i>two-month extension</i>)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – This two-month extension has been requested to synchronize submission of the CPD with the timeline of the national development plan, and to ensure proper sequencing of the CPD with the UNSDCF at the country level. – The extension has been coordinated with the United Nations Development Programme, the United Nations Population Fund and the Resident Coordinator’s Office to ensure that the next CPD is fully aligned with and derived from the final UNSDCF.
