people gained access to primary healthcare services, including first aid care



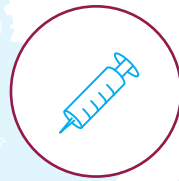

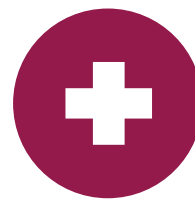

What do we need?



Unimpeded access to deliver critical health services – including routine immunization – especially in hard-to-reach and conflict-affected areas



Non-interference with delivery of health services and assurances of the safety and security of medical facilities and health staff



Public understanding, buy-in and support for the implementation of the health response plan



US\$16.7 million to expand MNCH and HIV programmes in the most vulnerable townships across Myanmar
