Jordan: National Vision for Education

Jordan's vision for education is to deliver free, inclusive and high-quality learning for every child in Jordan – regardless of nationality – by strengthening equity, improving learning outcomes, and building a resilient, crisis-responsive system.



Main challenges in education linked to learners and teachers

Learners

- Low foundational skills in reading, writing & maths
- Dropout and disengagement, especially among boys
- Inequitable access for refugees & children with disabilities
- Overcrowded classrooms and double-shift schools
- Wellbeing issues: stress, bullying & economic pressure
- Digital divide limiting learning opportunities
- Under-resourced learning environments

Teachers

- Teacher-centred, lecture-based methods dominate
- Limited training in inclusive, engaging & active pedagogy
- Weak follow-up and mentoring after training
- Large classes and heavy administrative load
- Low motivation, low salaries, limited career prospects
- Gaps in digital literacy and effective EdTech use
- Very packed, challenging curriculum

Supports recovery in Arabic literacy maths, through adaptive tools and interactive platforms.

Blended and AI-enabled training that empowers teachers to innovate, collaborate, and continuously improve.

Strengthened of Education Systems

Enhances data use and accountability through digital monitoring and real-time learning analytics.

A tablet-based assessment tool used in schools and non-formal settings, used to screen, place and to track learners' progress in reading and maths in real time.
